

Level 1 Child Protection

Course Description: E-learning training module in Child Protection Awareness; this course is the Swindon Local Safeguarding Children Board preferred method of delivery for this level of training. The Child Protection Level 1 course is an introduction to the concept of providing protection to children in your care. The course will cover understanding the concept of safeguarding children, the size of the challenge, how to spot issues of concern and what to do about them.

Target Group: All staff working in settings who may be in infrequent contact with children, young people and/or parents/carers who may become aware of possible abuse or neglect. This level is equivalent to basic safeguarding/child protection training across all partner organisations working with children and young people.

Training Level: Level 1

Pre-Requisite Learning: None

Aims/Objectives:

- To enable all people working with the care of children to understand the concepts of safeguarding children and child protection
- To recognise the signs and symptoms of abuse
- To be able to record appropriately any concerns they may have
- To feel confident in making referrals to the appropriate agencies
- To identify tools practitioners can use to raise concerns
