

Level 2 Child Protection

Course Description: Building on the Level 1 online module, or specific single agency training, this course looks at practitioner's individual roles and responsibilities and those of other agencies, working with families to safeguard children and young people. The course explores early help processes and thresholds of intervention, the referral system for child protection concerns, child in need and child protection processes, recording and confidentiality. The training will equip practitioners to understand the context and their responsibilities when safeguarding children.

Target Group: In addition to Level 1 training, Level 2 is for staff who work frequently with parents, children or young people

Training Level: Level 2

Pre-Requisite Learning: We recommend delegates complete Child Protection Awareness training (Level 1) before attending this course

Aims/Objectives:

- Be aware of the roles and responsibilities for safeguarding children and young people
- Be able to identify signs and indicators associated to the abuse and neglect of children
- Have an understanding of individual roles and responsibilities for safeguarding children
- Explore guidance set out in Working Together 2015 and Keeping Children Safe in Education 2016
- Review concepts of child vulnerability, child protection, children in need and significant harm
- Be aware of other agencies roles and responsibilities for early help, child protection and promoting the welfare of children
- Review local processes for reporting concerns
- Have an understanding about consent and confidentiality

Course Type: Classroom

Length of Course: 1 day
