

## The Right Help at the Right Time - LSCB Training Understanding & Applying Thresholds of Need and Risk

If you work with children and young people you have a responsibility for safeguarding them and promoting their welfare. To do this effectively you must understand the criteria for taking action that ensures that:

- Children achieve the best outcomes;
- Children's health and development is not impaired;
- Children grow up in circumstances consistent with safe and effective care; and,
- Children are protected from abuse and neglect.

Based on the LSCB guidance <u>'The Right Help at the Right Time'</u> this 3 hour workshop will:

- ✓ Help you to understand the thresholds for taking action in response to different levels of need and give you practical support in applying them to scenarios drawn from real cases.
- ✓ Give you the opportunity to work with colleagues from across the LSCB partnership as you develop a common understanding of the different levels of need and risk.
- ✓ Consider how best to share concerns you might have for children you work with to ensure that they receive the right help at the right time.
- Provide you with a better understanding of what to do if you disagree with another professional about the best way to meet a child's needs and how to do this within the context of the LSCBs Escalation policy
